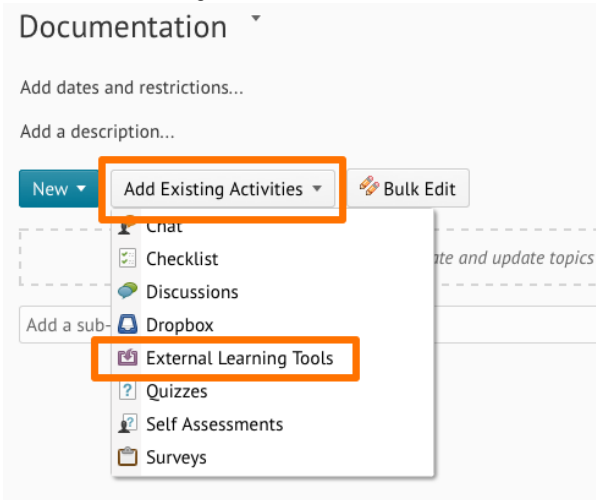

## 2. Adding McGraw-Hill Campus to your Course

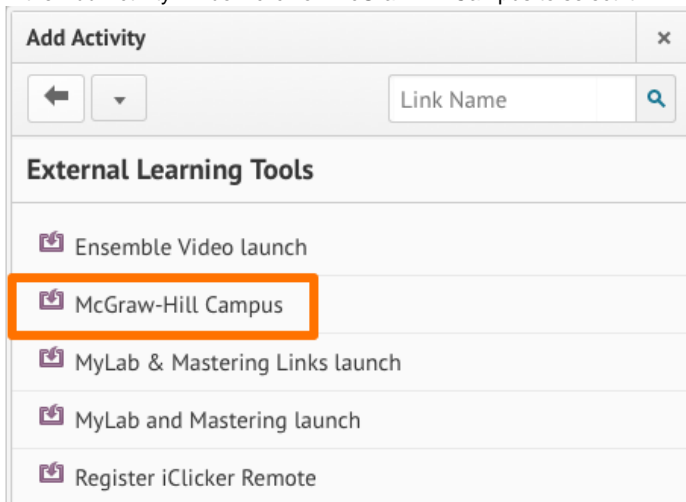
## 2.1. Content Integration
