INDIVIDUAL COURSES

- **Instructor-paced:** We recommend learners enroll in the course before the listed course start date for the best learning experience. Materials are released on a weekly basis and courses may have weekly deadlines, so starting the course on the start date is recommended so you do not fall behind.
- **Self-paced:** You can enroll at any time that the course is open.

EDX PROGRAM (MICROMASTERS, PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE, XSERIES)

There is not a separate deadline to enroll in an edX program. You can use the bulk enrollment feature on the program's home page to enroll in all courses at the same time if you wish. Or you can enroll in each course separately. After completing all courses on the verified track, you will receive the program credential.
