## Why are the 3 RITx Project Management courses different than the courses for the RIT Advanced Certificate in Project Management?

Although the titles for the three **RITx Project Management courses** that form the MicroMasters in Project Management differ from the corresponding courses in the RIT Advanced Certificate in Project Management, the core concepts and learning objectives for each RIT course and its equivalent MicroMasters instructional module are fundamentally the same. The titles differ solely for administrative reasons related to distinguishing which delivery mechanism is being used to deliver the content.
