Google- Advance Search Tips

- Search by file type
- Search for specific types of files, such as PDFs, PPTs, or XLS, by adding filetype: and the 3-letter file abbreviation.
- Use the related: operator to find pages that have similar content
- Get results that include synonyms by placing the ~ sign immediately in front of your search term.
- Precede your query with site: if you know you want your answer from within a specific site. For example: site:edu or site:nytimes.com
