

How can I get university credit?

How can I get university credit / academic credit?

University credit (academic credit) is awarded after completing the entire MicroMasters program as a verified learner and being accepted by the university. In rare cases, a university may award credit for completing individual courses as a verified learner.

MICROMASTERS PROGRAMS

After earning the **MicroMasters certificate**, students are eligible to apply to RIT for select graduate programs. If accepted into the program, students with the MicroMasters certificate will be awarded 9* credit hours towards their degree requirements. This allows learners to accelerate their degree completion and pursue an academic credential at a reduced overall cost. For your convenience, you can earn either degree by studying fully online or on campus.
